Pharmacy	Hazem, Manager at Southam Pharmacy joined the meeting to outline changes at the pharmacy. He also addressed concerns raised by the members. Hazem joined the pharmacy around two months ago. The pharmacy have a shortage of pharmacists, technicians and assistants, which has led to current problems. Hazem is trying to work with the system but they have been short staffed and without a manager for 3 months. No longer owned by Dudley Taylor – is a partner with Avicenna. Staff are doing their best and they are recruiting. Current turnaround time for acute scripts is 10-15 minutes. Repeat prescriptions take 3-4 working days (Backlog from the Bank Holiday and Covid cases). Hazem is working towards reducing to 1-2 days. Urgent requests for medication are dealt with quicker. Availability of medicines is poor. There have been sudden shortages in medication. New serious shortage protocol for estrogel. Likely to be more flexibility in future. Nigel has written to Avicenna on behalf of the council to raise concerns about the pharmacy service. Home deliveries are still available every day. Hazem will send his contact details to Lindsay via email.
